Minimum Qualifications

A professional architecture degree (BArch, MArch, or DArch), or a Master's Degree in a related field from an accredited US Department of Education or an internationally recognized institution, and a demonstration with evidence of strong professional work experience in architecture or a related field.

- Significant teaching experience.
- Registered architect or significant professional experience in the building design industry.
- Proficiency in architectural design and/or analysis software, such as Revit, AutoCAD, Sketchup, Rhino, Adobe Suite (Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign), building performance modeling, or other related software.
